Purpose	Manage to status quo	Create Change
Management Involvement	Low Decisions pre-established	High New situations
Structure	Existing	Temporary Cross-functional

Leader vs. Manager

☉ Leader

- Someone who sets direction in an effort, and positively influences others to follow in that same direction
- Focus is on envisioning, guiding, inspiring
- *Doing the right thing*

☉ Manager (Project Manager)

- Responsible for managing the efforts of others to get stated goals completed in a timely fashion
- Focus is analyzing, navigating, measuring and control
- *Doing things right*

• Continued '*business case*' justification



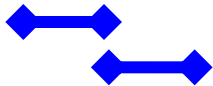
• Defined project organization, roles & responsibilities

• Learn from experience



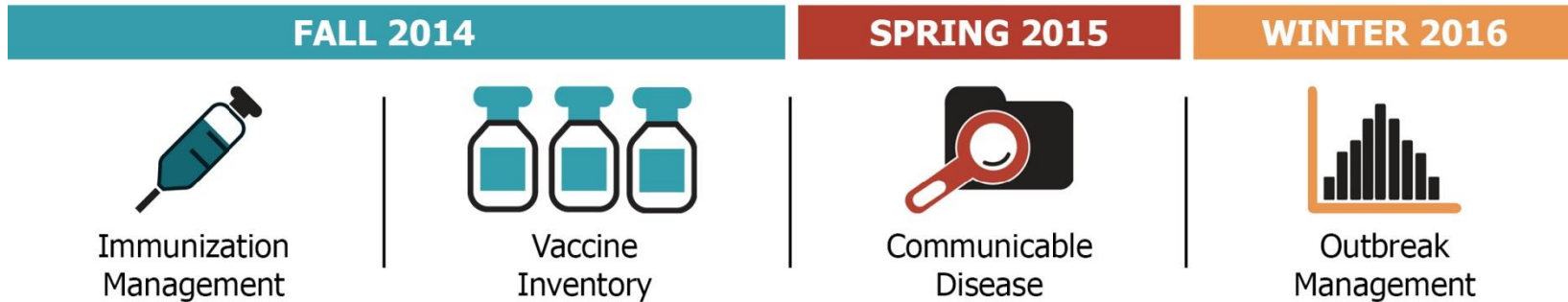
Panorama

- ② The public health electronic clinical record and information management system used to support the delivery of public health services by Manitoba Regional Health Authorities, Manitoba Health, Health Canada, First Nation Organizations and health-care providers.

- ② The authoritative source of public health information about Manitobans, used by Manitoba health care providers for:
 - Communicable Diseases
 - Outbreaks
 - Surveillance
 - Provincial Immunization Registry
 - Immunizations and vaccine safety
 - Inventory related to vaccines and other public health drugs and supplies

- The project will deliver the following core functional areas in three releases:
 - Immunization & Inventory – Pilot targeted fall 2014.
 - Communicable Disease – Pilot targeted spring 2015
 - Outbreak Management – Pilot targeted winter 2015
- Relevant work management, notifications and shared services will be included in each release
